May 23 2017 Meeting

The Situation in Ukraine and Canada's Response

Orest Zakydalsky made the presentation on the topic, *The Situation in Ukraine and Canada's Response*. Orest is the Senior Policy Advisor at the Ukrainian Canadian Congress (UCC) and has been in Ottawa since February, 2014. He spoke on the military and economic situation in Ukraine and Canadian aid to Ukraine through various programs.

Orest outlined the UCC position and priorities relating to security and defence, sanctions and international assistance. As a result of aid from Canada, there has been progress in a number of areas however, some serious problems continue to plague the Ukrainian government and society. The war with Russia through their surrogates in eastern Ukraine is a drain on Ukrainian financial and human resources.

There is a stronger need for transparency among Ukrainian politicians, public servants, bankers and businessmen. Now all government officials must list their property to stem corruption. Ukrainian government procurement provides opportunities for macro-corruption schemes so there are plans for open source and open tender approaches to government business.

Orest also spoke about the emigration of Ukrainians to Canada that is relatively small. He mentioned plans for Ukraine to join NATO that is a long term process that may culminate by 2020. He described some actions by UCC in the diplomatic sphere by supporting the implementation of the Magnitsky Law and the use of the SWIFT financial system to impose further sanctions on Russia. The session was followed by a question-and-answer period.
